In Drush 8 you can download a module using a command: drush dl module\_name. To install a module using Drush, execute the command below: drush en module\_name. Clear the cache using a command. drush cr. Go to the browser refresh the page. You will see the functionality of the module is added to the site. Be sure that your version of drush is appropriate for your version of drupal. Otherwise you might encounter errors.

Install the files you need to run Drupal. Step 2: Install dependencies with composer. If you installed or updated the codebase using git, then install required PHP libraries with composer.
